Procedure: Attach a 10-20ml oral/enteral syringe to the enteral tube in the infant/child ; Attach a 5-10ml oral/enteral syringe to the enteral tube in a neonate ; Aspirate minimum 0.5 - 1ml of gastric content (or sufficient amount to enable pH testing). Consider the "dead space" in the tubing.
