The Nebraska Pesticide Act provides for two basic types of pesticide applicator licensing, either a private or a commercial. Currently, the NDA certifies and licenses approximately 22,250 private and 9,250 commercial pesticide applicators. If the applicant applies for a Certified Commercial Applicator license in Category 7A, Category 7B, or Category 7C the applicant will be required to submit evidence of valid experience using pesticides (in these categories) while under the direct supervision of a Certified Commercial Applicator or evidence of having an Associates of Arts degree or its equivalent in Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture, or Entomology by submitting a copy of the degree or college transcript.

Certified Applicators & Operators

People seeking initial certification (a prerequisite of licensing) as commercial or noncommercial pesticide applicators in Nebraska must successfully pass a general standards core exam and one or more specific category examinations, proctored by NDA. Then, the person is considered competent

to apply pesticides and is certified.

Training dates are set for Nebraska's commercial and noncommercial pesticide applicators seeking first-time certification or recertification of their license to use or purchase restricted use pesticides in 2018. The statewide training is coordinated through the Nebraska Extension Pesticide Safety Education Program (PSEP).
