Pick the pine cones off the tree. Grab a pine cone in your hand and, with a twisting motion, pull it until it separates from the tree branch. Place the pine cone in a container and continue picking until you have enough for your needs. Alternative Collection Method: If it is already late in the season and the pine cones have opened up, then you can use this method for gathering the pine nuts. Put a big tarp under the pine tree. Then shake the branches of the pine tree really hard. This will make the remaining pine nuts (the ones which haven't been eaten by critters yet) fall out of the cones and land on your tarp.

How to Harvest Your Own Pine Nuts in the Wild - Primal ...

Pinus pinea is the specimen of pine from which most commercial nuts are harvested. When growing pine nuts, choose a variety of pine with large enough seeds to easily harvest and a tree that is adaptable to your region. Fortunately, most pine trees are very tolerant of a wide range of soils and climates.
